The Executive Legislative Representative represents Metropolitan's interests before the State Legislature and Executive Branch and plays a critical role in promoting and protecting Metropolitan's near- and long-term legislative, regulatory, and policy objectives. The position is also responsible for managing a small internal staff along with contract consultants.
