Description

The UCLA Department of Philosophy is offering a two-year post-doctoral research fellowship to a recent Ph.D. in philosophy whose primary area of research lies in ethics, political philosophy, and social philosophy. We especially welcome applications from scholars whose research addresses issues concerning diversity, such as philosophy of race, philosophy of gender, or other philosophical investigations into hierarchy, oppression, and the liberation therefrom.

The fellow is required to teach two quarter-length courses in the first year and one quarter-length course in the second year of the fellowship; the fellow will also be asked to attend talks and conferences, and to participate actively in the philosophy department community. The bulk of their time will be devoted to independent research.

Required Skills

Typical candidates will have a doctorate in philosophy, to be granted no later than June 30, 2019. The fellowship offers a competitive salary, small research stipend, and full benefits with a start date in mid-September 2019. One or two postdoctoral fellowships will be available depending on funding.

Consideration will also be given to candidates whose experience in teaching, research, or community service has prepared them to contribute to diversity and excellence.
