The University of Virginia School of Law in conjunction with the Institute for Law, Psychiatry and Public Policy seeks a Research Specialist to coordinate research efforts on mental health law and mental health-criminal justice reform in Virginia. The Research Specialist will be actively involved in all aspects of research, implementation, and writing bearing on reforms to the intersection of mental health-criminal justice in Virginia. The incumbent will have the opportunity to develop expertise in designing and studying the implementation of policy and practice innovations involving persons with serious mental illness in the criminal justice system. The incumbent will assist the PI in coordinating research and collaborating with stakeholders outside UVA to further policy and practice reform. The incumbent will conduct literature reviews, research interviews, data analysis, manuscript preparation, and study management, as well. In addition, a small portion of the incumbent's work will include assisting with training facilitators of advance directives with mental health care instructions.
