Description

Oregon State Treasury (OST) is recruiting for the position of ISS7 (Network Engineer). This position will be located in our Salem, Oregon location. This position will report to the Network Services Manager and is part of the Information Technology Division.

This recruitment will be used to fill one current vacancy. This is represented by SEIU.

The Oregon State Treasury is the state of Oregon's financial hub. It oversees the investment of a public trust fund portfolio that is approaching \$100 billion in assets under management, and is diversified across a variety of capital market and alternative investment strategies. To manage that portfolio, Treasury also maintains supporting functions including internal auditing, investment operations, legal, compliance, corporate governance and cybersecurity. Treasury manages a banking program that processes more than \$250 billion in transactions annually, a debt management program responsible for issuing and monitoring approximately \$10 billion in state debt, and a defined contribution program that allows members of the public to invest via 529 savings funds for higher education or disability-related costs, and via IRAs for retirement.

The Oregon State Treasury (OST) is expanding its Network Services Team to support a growing network infrastructure and ever-increasing cybersecurity challenges. OST currently has an exciting opportunity for a qualified and experienced Network Engineer with network infrastructure management, monitoring, troubleshooting and tuning experience.

You will work with a wide range of the latest network technologies including enterprise firewalls, switches, routers, and network performance monitoring and management tools.

You will need to have excellent communication and time management skills, be self-motivated, have excellent attention to detail, and be able to think strategically.

Your responsibilities will include:

- Design, install, manage, and upgrade network infrastructure and security devices including but not limited to firewalls, servers, switches, routers, and cabling.
- Design, install, manage and upgrade physical infrastructure for the OST network including but not limited to cabling, rack configuration, cooling, power, and UPS.
- Collaborate with the Security team to implement security controls identified to protect data on OST's network infrastructure.
- Detect, diagnose, and resolve network performance issues.
- Configure and tune alerts to monitor network, server, and application performance and availability issues.
- Provide network performance and uptime reports for management and technical staff.

- Work with IT management to develop technology roadmaps.
- Work with IT management to determine product direction.

OST offers an attractive benefits package, which provides contributions toward individual, family health, dental, and term life insurance, sponsored by the Public Employee Benefit Board (PEBB). Other benefits include participation in the Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan (OPSRP), paid holidays, paid vacation and both sick and personal leave time. A Bachelor's degree in Information Technology, Computer Science, or related field; AND two (2) years of information systems experience in enterprise level network infrastructure management, monitoring, troubleshooting and tuning experience;

OR

A Master's degree in Information Technology, Computer Science or a related field may substitute for all of the above.
