Qualifications Requirements include: Doctorate in music education required; ABD will be considered. Significant record of teaching K-12 music within the public school system. Interest in program building and recruitment from high school programs and youth ensembles. Successful applicant will demonstrate scholarly activities commensurate with their level of experience in order to secure tenure. Experience as a conductor of a choral ensemble preferred.

Responsibilities Teach nine credit hours (normally three 3-credit courses per semester), possible music education courses include undergraduate Introduction to Music Education, undergraduate upper-division music education literature and pedagogy courses, and graduate level MAT music education courses.

Semester courses may include supervision of student teaching and/or master's capstone projects for students enrolled in the College of Education credential program and MAT program with emphasis in music education, choral conducting courses, or a choral ensemble. Recruit for and build the music education program, including possibly directing a summer choral camp.

Contribute to the academic/artistic/creative community by participating in appropriate departmental and university committees. Tenure track faculty are expected to develop and maintain an active research agenda for future tenure consideration and are evaluated on their research/scholarly activity, teaching and service.

The Conservatory of Music is part of the College of Performing Arts and consists of 19 full-time faculty members and approximately 63 adjunct instructors, many of whom are established professionals in Los Angeles and Orange counties.
